

# Leeds, Grenville & Lanark District Health Unit (LGLDHU) Weekly Influenza Surveillance Summary

issued: Monday December 07, 2009 – 12:00 Hrs

**Summary:** This summary contains H1N1 surveillance data for the week of Nov 28—Dec 04, 2009. The trend in Respiratory/Fever/ILI complaints at local hospital ED's continues to decline. Daily ED visit counts remain below the moving average. This trend has also been observed in hospitals in other health unit jurisdictions (KFLA, HPE, PCCHU).

In LGL reporting hospitals, Respiratory/Fever/ILI complaints accounted for 14.6% of ED visits for the week.

**Lab update:** LGLDHU currently has 1 lab-confirmed H1N1 case for this reporting period which is the same as last week (Nov 21—Nov 27).

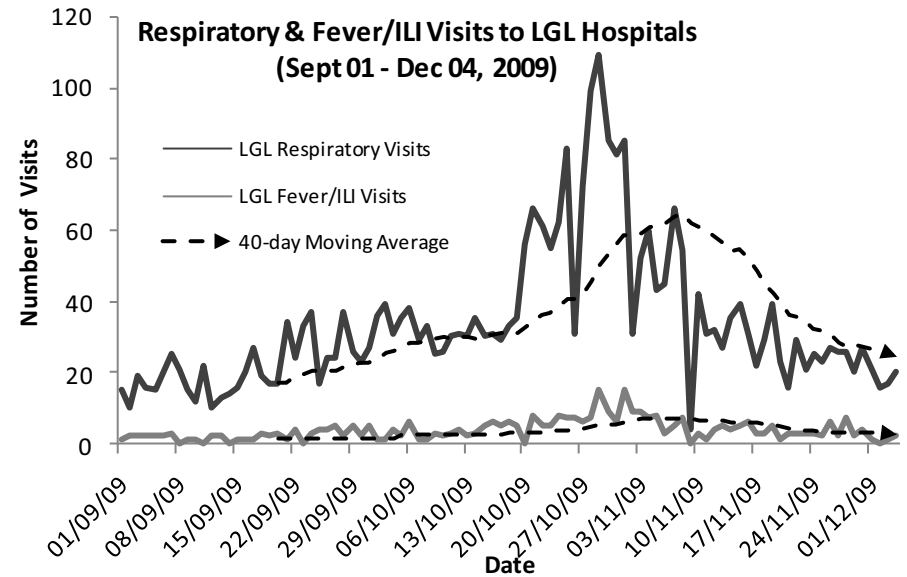
