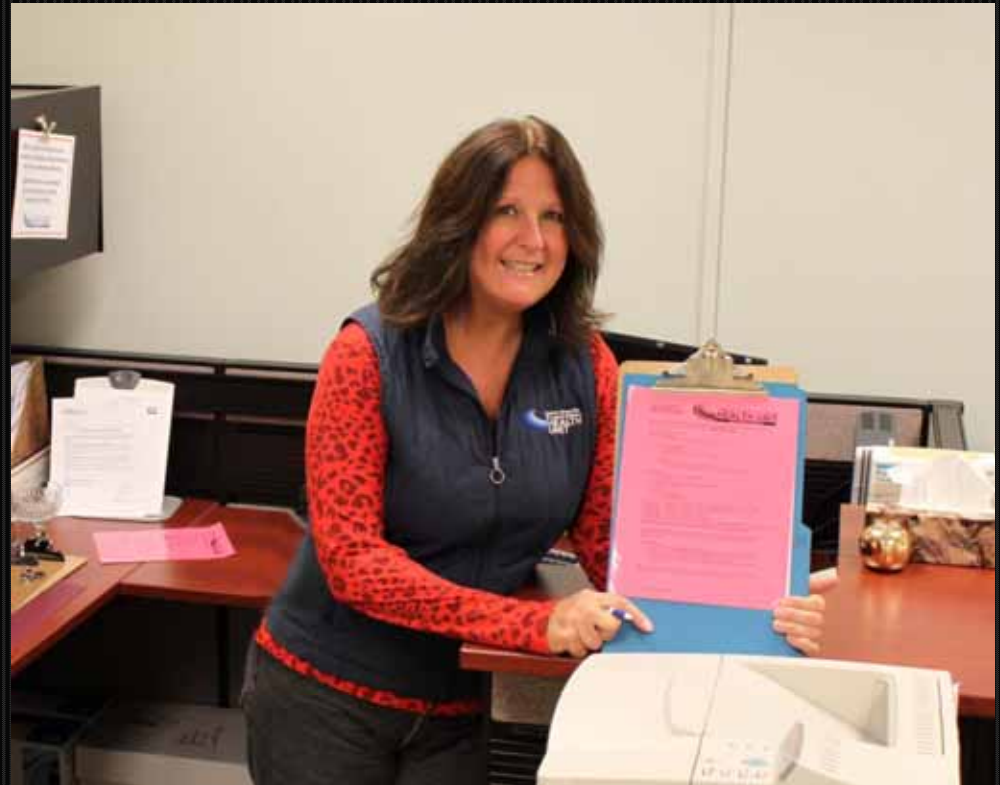

- This is the only service that requires an *appointment and your Health Card*

# Things to remember about our Sexual Health Clinics:

- Free and confidential
- Staff are 'youth friendly' and non-judgmental
- You do not need to have your Health Card with you (*except for Paps*)
- You do **NOT** need your parent's permission
- Clinics are not just for girls!
- You can visit just to talk or ask questions



# A few last points to consider:

- Clinics are for **everyone**, regardless of sexual orientation and gender
- You can bring a friend, parent, or guardian with you for support
- Come to clinic **with** your boyfriend/girlfriend, especially if you want STI testing
- We do not have to see you naked! Most STI tests just require a urine and/or blood sample.
