

Dental Program for Children In Need Of Treatment (CINOT)

What is it?

CINOT is a provincially and municipally funded program for children in need of dental treatment. This program ensures that Ontario children in need of urgent dental care can receive immediate treatment.

Who is eligible?

All children, up to and including 17 years of age, who live in Ontario and:

- have dental conditions that could cause pain or infection
- are not covered by any insurance plan
- do not qualify for assistance under a provincial social assistance program that already includes dental coverage
- for whom the cost of treatment would be a financial hardship.



How does the Program work?



The Health Unit team provides dental screening in Tri-County elementary schools on an annual basis. Upon request, dental screenings will be provided to anyone in the Tri-County area. If you would like to arrange a dental screening, please contact the Health Unit.

What dental care is covered under the Program?

This program covers some basic restorative care and preventive dental services, including:

- cleaning
- fillings
- x-rays
- extractions
- root canal treatment
