The Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit Service site in Gananoque is temporarily changing reception services in the office. There will be in-person reception coverage on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 8am to 4pm only. The local telephone number will be answered in the office by the receptionist on Tuesday and Wednesdays. Monday, Thursday and Friday the phone will be forwarded to the 1-800 number and answered in the Brockville Office.

Water bottles for testing well water can be picked up any day between 8am and 4pm and dropped off Monday to Thursday as usual. However, water bottles are now to be placed in the refrigerator in the lobby. Sewage permit applications can be dropped off any day between 8 and 4 and placed in a locked, secure drop box. Check the signage on the door and in the reception area for detailed instructions.
